Subject: **Payment of ex-gratia lump-sum compensation to Indian Coast Guard personnel who are boarded out of service on account of disability attributable to or aggravated in service**

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of President of India for grant of ex-gratia lump-sum compensation to the Indian Coast Guard Personnel, who are disabled in performance of their bona-fide official duties under various circumstances and are boarded-out from service on account of disability attributable to or aggravated in the service.

2. The amount of such ex-gratia compensation for 100% disability would be Rs. 9 lakhs (Rupees nine lakhs only). For disability/war injury less than 100% but not less than 20%, the amount of ex-gratia compensation shall be proportionately reduced. No ex-gratia compensation shall be payable for disability/war injury less than 20%. The proportion of compensation would be based on actual percentage of disability certified by the Invaliding Medical Board with-out applying broad banding provisions contained in DOP & PW's OM No. 45/22/97-P&PW(C) dated 03-02-2000, as amended from time to time.

3. The other terms and conditions for admissibility of ex-gratia lump-sum compensation will be applicable as mentioned in Department of Pension & Pensioners Welfare OM No. 45/55/97-P&PW(C) dated 11-09-1998 and No. 38/37/08-P&PW(A) dated 02-09-2008. as amended from time to time.

4. The provisions of this letter shall apply to all cases of Coast Guard Personnel boarded out on or after 01 April 2011 on account of disability attributable to or aggravated in service.

5. This issues with the concurrence of the Ministry of Defence (Finance) vide their Dy No. 289/Fin/CG dated 27-06-2014.
