Sub :- Special delegation of powers for restoration of roads connecting for Chardham Yatra in Uttarakhand by BRO

Sir,

I am directed to refer to Dte GBR letter No. 20300/SHVLK/Chardham/DGBR/01/TP (Wks) dated 07th February 2014 vide which Dte GBR has forwarded a proposal for Special dispensation/delegation of powers for restoration of roads connecting for Chardham Yatra in Uttarakhand by Border Roads Organization.

2. The approval of Competent Authority to the proposal of BRO for special delegation of powers for restoration of roads connecting for Chardham Yatra in Project Shivalik as enumerated in Column (2) of table below is hereby accorded as outlined in Column (3) of the table below :-

(vi)	<p><u>Spot tendering for hiring of equipment:</u> CEs should be permitted to hire plant/eqpt for a period of six months through spot tendering.</p>	<p>The proposal is agreed to subject to a ceiling of Rs. 5 lacs only to be exercised with the concurrence of ACDA/DCDA/SAO of the Project.</p>
(vii)	<p>Expenditure be booked in suspense head in accounting & to be regularized later.</p>	<p>The proposal is NOT agreed to as booking expenditure without sanctioning is involved.</p> <p>Need for booking to suspense head does not arise since sanction is to be accorded by the Chief Engineer.</p>
(viii)	<p>Advance procurement of FOL, Cement, Bitumen, Chain link fence and other construction stores without Adm approval/technical sanction</p>	<p>As CE is empowered to issue Administrative Approval, there is no need for advance procurement.</p> <p>However, if so deemed necessary approval may be accorded for lump sum amount towards bulk procurement. CE will ensure proper credit, no over stocking or deterioration/loss of the procured items.</p>

3. The revised powers and relaxation will be applicable to project Shivalik, which covers Uttarakhand roads on Chardham Yatra route which are to be handed over back to State Govt.

4. These powers and dispensation would automatically lapse and cease to be valid with effect from 31.03.2015.

5. This issues with the concurrence of MOD (Fin/BR) vide their U.O. No. 52/BRS/14 dated 19th March 2014.
